Word Count Cinquain

A Word Count Cinquain poem does not rhyme. It follows a pattern of 5 lines containing 11 words.

Line 1 - one word (noun: title)

Line 2 - two words (adjectives: describe the title)

Line 3 - three words (verbs: actions of the title)

Line 4 - four word phrase (describe a feeling or statement)

Line 5 - one word (synonym: refer back to the title)

Examples:

Chocolate
Sweet, creamy
Unwrap, chew, swallow
Yummy in the tummy
Heaven

Mom
Nice, beautiful
Clean, shop, kiss
I love her forever
Mama
