***EXTENDED* LEARNING CHOICE BOARD**

LITERACY

Choose a new family member to read to each day, provide them with a short summary before reading (if you are reading a novel) or read them a short picture book or story. If you run out of family members in your direct house, try out a Zoom call or phone call and read to a family member farther away!

NUMERACY

Look around your home or neighbourhood. Where do you see numbers? Take photos or record the numbers you find on a piece of paper. What numbers are most common? How are numbers used in your home or neighbourhood?

CREATIVE

Create a scene using fingerprint art. Visit the <u>libraryplus.ca</u> website page to see examples of how you can transform a fingerprint into something else! All you need is a washable felt, ink pad or paint to dip your fingers into and a black felt or pen to add the details.

INTEGRATED STUDIES

Go on <u>mystery science</u> and check out this video about birds laying eggs in the springtime. After you watch the video, Can you build a nest that will hold an egg? Give it a try. If you can go outside, gather twigs, leaves, and grass to build with — just like birds do! If you can't go out, use torn paper, rolled up paper, and string. You can't use glue or tape! When you're done building, test your nest with something round — like a marble, or even a real egg! Also, see if you can answer some of these questions:

1. Why do birds lay eggs in the spring?

2. What did this lesson make you curious about? What other questions do you have about birds?
