EXTENDED LEARNING CHOICE BOARD

LITERACY

Choose a person you are interested in learning more about. It could be an athlete, a musician, a politician or even someone from your own family. Do some research by reading, interviewing, and/or viewing information about them. Choose how you would like to share what you learned with others. For example, create a poster, a google slide, Book Creator, a brochure, a PowerPoint or other format.

NUMERACY

Find a recipe you would like to make with a family member. Rewrite the recipe and TRIPLE the ingredients. How many people does your recipe serve? Write out the new recipe measurements. Which measurement was the hardest to triple? What form of the recipe would you need to make for your family? (single, double, triple, quadruple, etc.)

CREATIVE

Do a shadow drawing! You'll need: paper, a pencil, a sunny day, and a figurine that will create a distinctive shadow (a plastic dinosaur works well) Start by taking your supplies outside and finding a sunny spot. Set your figurine on top of the paper in a position where you can see the shadow of the object. Trace it with pencil, colour it, and add details. Extension: go back every half hour and re-trace to see where the sun has moved in the sky and how that relates to the figurine's shadow

SCIENCE

Find a seed in your kitchen (beans, lemon, lime, orange, avocado, etc). Research how to plant the seed and what it needs to grow. Record the step in a notebook or journal. If possible, plant the seed and take daily notes about what you have done to help it grow and what the plant looks like.
