LITERACY

A picture is worth a thousand words. Think about picture books and remember that picture books are not only for younger readers. Who tells the story better? The author or the illustrator? Think about arguments/reasons for both sides. Perhaps this could be a friendly debate topic. Ask your family members for their opinion.

NUMERACY

Which numbers that are less than 100 are **square numbers** and explain how you know? Use a picture or model in your explanation. You may have to do some research to figure out what a square number is.

PHYSICAL ACTIVITY
