

***EXTENDED* LEARNING CHOICE BOARD**

LITERACY

Watch a fictional TV show or movie, paying close attention to the story elements. Next, record the story elements either on paper or on a computer. Make sure to include: characters, plot, setting, conflict, solution, and important events.

NUMERACY

It's your turn to be the teacher! Find or create a difficult, but solvable multiplication or division question. Record yourself (on a phone or tablet) solving the question; explaining how you did it along the way. Don't forget to show your work!

CREATIVE

"My Pet as a Human" Portrait - You'll need: pencil, unlined paper, your imagination
Start by sketching the head of your pet, or any type of animal. Make sure to shade and add lots of detail.
Next, start on the upper body, BUT, you'll be giving your animal a human body. Will your cat be an astronaut, your dog a barista, or your fish a scuba diver? Get creative and remember portraits only include the head, neck, and shoulders.

SCIENCE

Place an icecube in a cup and leave out on your dinner table. Time how long it takes to melt. Repeat the experiment, but in different environments: try it once in the fridge, once outside in direct sunlight, and once in the shade. What do you notice? Explain the results and how the independent variable changed.
